Parade Route:

The parade will start on the Island, then across the bridge, turn right onto Jerry Plemmons Way, turn left onto Bridge St, at the traffic light turn left onto Main Street, proceed thru downtown Marshall turning around at the old Farm Bureau office then proceed South on Main Street to the traffic light at the Courthouse then turn right, back to the Island.

Parade Rules and Guidelines

1. SAFETY is our primary concern. Please help us reduce risk by being observant of your surroundings, particularly children, along the parade route.
2. Entries must pertain to the Holiday season.
3. Candy may be thrown out along the parade route. If thrown from a vehicle, please toss candy from the side of vehicles toward the sidewalk and not at individuals. Do not throw objects toward the front of the vehicle.
4. Entries with animals must provide their own clean-up during the line-up and along the parade route.
5. No open wheel trailers. All trailers must have fenders that cover the wheels.
6. No alcohol use allowed.
7. Cancellation Policy: Cancellation information will be announced via the Town of Marshall website, Facebook page, and should a cancellation be necessary, the parade will not be rescheduled.
