SECTION 5: There is hereby levied a tax rate of .49 cents per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property listed as of January 01, 2016 for the purpose of raising revenue included in "2016 Ad Valorem Taxes" in the General Fund in Section 2 of this ordinance. This rate of tax is based on as estimated total valuation of property for the purpose of taxation of \$88,055,171 and as estimated rate of collection of 95%

- SECTION 6: The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to transfer appropriations as Contained herein under the following conditions:
 - A. The Finance Officer shall be authorized to transfer amounts between line items expenditures within a department without limitation and without a report being required. These changes should not result in increases in recurring obligations such as salaries.
- SECTION 7: The Finance Officer is hereby restricted from transferring appropriations as contained herein under the following conditions:
 - A. The utilization of any contingency appropriation shall be accomplished only with Board authorization.
 - B. No salary increases may be made without Board approval.
 - C. No new positions/vacancies temporary or full-time may be filled without Board approval.
- SECTION 8: This ordinance shall be the basis of the financial plans of the Town of Marshall during 2016-2017 Fiscal Year. The Finance Officer shall administer the budget and shall insure that the operating officials are provided guidance and sufficient detail to implement their appropriate portion of the budget. The accounting section shall establish records which are in consonance with the budget and this ordinance and the appropriate statutes of the State of North Carolina.

SECTION 9: Copies of the Budget Ordinance shall be furnished to the Clerk of the Board of Aldermen and to the Finance Officer to be kept on file by them for their direction in the disbursement of funds.
