WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS TOWN OF MARSHALL

Sealed bids for the project entitled **Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements** will be received by the **Town of Marshall** until **11:00 A.M.** local time **February 19th, 2026**, in the **Marshall Town Hall** located at **10 Derringer Drive, Marshall NC, 28753**. At said place and time, all Bids that have been duly received, will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bid may be submitted electronically to: Town of Marshall Administrator, Ryan Cody, at administrator@townofmarshall.org.

THE PROJECT GENERALLY CONSISTS OF: **Conversion of the UV chamber (precast concrete tank) to a chlorine contact basin. Work includes the following: removal of UV equipment within the tank and on the UV access bridge; relocation of the aluminum metal grating and support to a higher elevation in the tank; removal of UV inlet and outlet equipment; installation of a new control valve on the outlet piping; installation of steel baffle walls; removal of floodproof door in UV vault and closure of the opening with a cast-in-place concrete wall; new chemical feed piping from the existing chemical feed pumps; handrail and grating modifications as needed; miscellaneous electrical work, relocation of the effluent samples, site restoration and cleanup.**
